English communication is the order of the day. Integrating technology into education, we use English learning software and Tablets for classes from LKG TO V std. We are also enriching the student English listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills through assessment by coordinators from English Learning Foundation every month. This month feedback report by them noted major advancement among lower class students, while noting few improvements to be made for class V students' in conversation skills.



EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES



Fine arts education should always be a part of any well-rounded curriculum. This year, we introduced Music, Mirudangam, and Key board. We are introducing Violin and Flute in the next academic year.

Taking steps towards educating children about the life skills, Financial Education has been introduced this year for IV standard.

AI AND ROBOTICS

We, at National Vidyalaya, understand the importance of equipping students to the tech-dominated future. This year, we had a lecture by Dr.Kamakoti, Professor from IIT- Madras, on the importance of Artificial Intelligence. We already have introduced Robotics for students last year.

At this juncture, we are proud to inform that Rishivel of IX std. attended an AI training programme at Bharathiya Vidya Bhavan at Chennai for 3 days and he also did a project "Money Converter" along with his team.

In the next Academic year, we plan to have extensive workshops on AI and robotics for kids.



INTERNAL COMPETITIONS
